Exercise-01. Creating a document – EXAMPLE

- (i) **by going to File → New → Select a template by D-click on one the 'Create Cover Letter....'** template.
- (ii) Blank doc – D-click;
- (iii) Blank doc – Press ENTER / Esc.

Objective: Go to File-tab, and select a file. By D-clicking on it, the file will be seen to open.
