

THE PRACTICE OF Well Test Interpretation

Golden Rules:

- 1 Well Test Interpretation (WTI) is much more than Pressure Transient Analysis (PTA).
- 2 If it happens suddenly... it is not a reservoir effect.
- 3 The longer the flow period, the more information you can extract from the buildup.
- 4 It is better to measure something than to calculate it.
- 5 Good measurements cost money. Bad ones cost more!
- 6 Be very critical of all data.
- 7 Use end points (e.g. p_i) as anchor points, to guide your interpretation.
- 8 Interpolate with no fear. Extrapolate only based on mechanistic models.
- 9 What the recorder sees, is not always what the reservoir sees.
- 10 Wellbore transients will dominate over reservoir transients.
- 11 Examine the PPD to differentiate between WELLBORE and RESERVOIR effects.
- 12 No matter how complex the reservoir is – be it fractured, multi-layered (with equal p_i), bounded, multi-permeability, etc... a buildup (in Cartesian coordinates) will ALWAYS be continuously concave downward (for a single phase fluid).
- 13 Draw a wellbore schematic. PTA refers to sandface pressures NOT recorder pressures.
- 14 When possible, run a gradient survey BEFORE and AFTER a test.
- 15 Run gradient survey to lowest perforation.
- 16 Read the field notes. Compare wellhead tubing / casing pressures (and temperature) to those of the bottomhole recorder.
- 17 If you torture data long enough it will confess to anything!
- 18 Even temperature has secrets to reveal.
- 19 Remember, the computer is only a calculator, not an interpreter.
- 20 **KEEP IT SIMPLE!**
