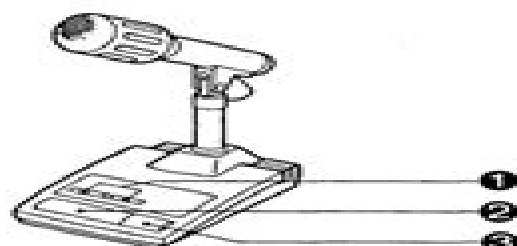

The **SM-20** is a unidirectional, electret microphone designed for base station operation with an Icom transceiver.

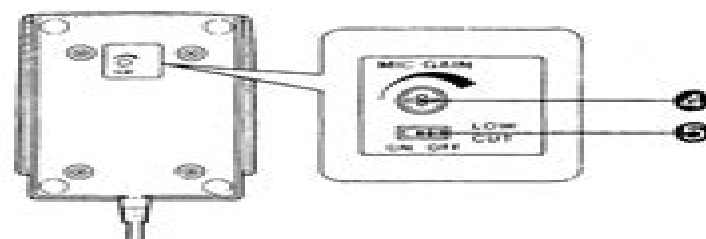
The **SM-20** cannot be used with a non-Icom transceiver since the power is supplied from the connected transceiver.

FRONT VIEW



- ① FREQUENCY UP/DOWN SWITCHES [UP] / [DOWN]**
Change the frequency up or down. Some transceivers do not have this function.
- ② PTT SWITCH**
Push to transmit, then release to receive.
- ③ PTT LOCK SWITCH [LOCK]**
Push IN to transmit continuously, then push OUT to receive.

BOTTOM VIEW

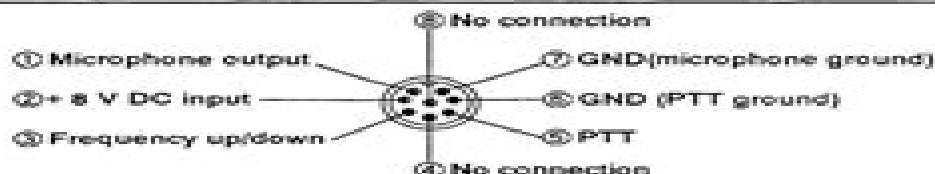


- ④ MIC GAIN CONTROL [MIC GAIN]**
Varies microphone output level. Use this control when the connected transceiver has no mic gain controls.
- ⑤ LOW CUT SWITCH [LOW CUT]**
Cuts out low-frequency components of input voice signals.

NOTE: Rotating the control too far clockwise may result in overmodulation and transmit signal distortion.
