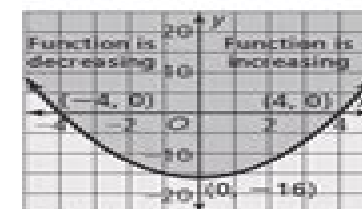
Key Features of Functions
