A dental implant involves surgically mounting a post or into your upper or lower jaw. After a few months, a crown is then mounted to the implant, which allows the tooth to remain in place.



Dentures

Dentures are a suitable solution for people who have many teeth missing. They are not as invasive as they can be taken out and placed back into the mouth. There are two types of dentures, full and partial.



Bridges

A dental bridge bridges a gap caused by a missing tooth using by attaching a dental prosthetic to the adjacent teeth and then bonding the prosthetic in place using dental cement.
