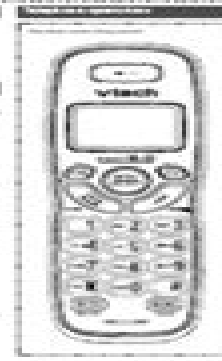

### Discussion

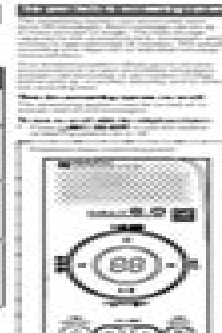
There are a number of limitations to this study. First, the sample was not representative of the general population of the United States. Second, the study was cross-sectional and did not include a control group. Third, the study did not include a measure of social support. Fourth, the study did not include a measure of self-esteem. Fifth, the study did not include a measure of coping strategies. Sixth, the study did not include a measure of life satisfaction. Seventh, the study did not include a measure of psychological well-being. Eighth, the study did not include a measure of physical well-being. Ninth, the study did not include a measure of overall health. Tenth, the study did not include a measure of quality of life.

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**QUESTION** A 60-year-old man with a 10-year history of type 2 diabetes mellitus presents with a 2-week history of increasing fatigue, weight loss, and decreased appetite. He reports that he has been unable to eat as much as he used to and has lost about 10 pounds. He also mentions that he has been experiencing frequent urination and increased thirst. His medical history is significant for type 2 diabetes mellitus, hypertension, and hyperlipidemia. He is currently taking insulin glargine and insulin lispro, metoprolol, and atorvastatin. He has no known allergies. His last medical checkup was 6 months ago, where his blood sugar was well-controlled. He is a retired teacher and lives with his wife. He is concerned about his symptoms and wants to know what might be causing them.

**ANSWER** The patient's symptoms are highly suggestive of a complication of his type 2 diabetes mellitus. The combination of increasing fatigue, weight loss, decreased appetite, frequent urination, and increased thirst is characteristic of hyperglycemia. The fact that his blood sugar was well-controlled 6 months ago suggests that his diabetes may be becoming more difficult to manage. The most likely cause of these symptoms is a significant increase in his blood glucose levels, which could be due to a variety of factors, including a change in his insulin regimen, a decrease in his physical activity, or the development of a new condition such as a pancreatic islet cell tumor (insulinoma) or a pituitary adenoma. The patient should be evaluated by his primary care physician or an endocrinologist to determine the cause of his symptoms and to adjust his treatment accordingly.
