Types of Data

Quantitative - numerical data that can be measured

Qualitative - non-numerical data that describes qualities

Primary - data collected first-hand from the source

Secondary - data collected from existing sources

Discrete - data that can only take specific values

Continuous - data that can take any value within a range

Population - the entire group of individuals being studied

Sample - a subset of the population

Sampling - the process of selecting a sample from a population

Random Sampling - every member of the population has an equal chance of being selected

Systematic Sampling - selecting every kth member of the population

Stratified Sampling - dividing the population into strata and sampling from each

Cluster Sampling - dividing the population into clusters and sampling from one or more clusters

Measures of Central Tendency

Mean - the average of all values

Median - the middle value when data is ordered

Mode - the most frequent value

Range - the difference between the highest and lowest values

Interquartile Range (IQR) - the range between the first and third quartiles

Standard Deviation - a measure of the spread of the data

Variance - the square of the standard deviation

Coefficient of Variation - a measure of relative variability

Probability

Sample Space - the set of all possible outcomes

Event - a subset of the sample space

Probability - the chance of an event occurring

Independent Events - events that do not affect each other

Dependent Events - events that do affect each other

Conditional Probability - the probability of an event occurring given that another event has occurred

Bayes' Theorem - a formula for calculating conditional probability

Statistics in Real Life

Market Research - used by companies to understand their customers

Quality Control - used to ensure products meet standards

Healthcare - used to analyze patient data and treatment outcomes

Education - used to evaluate student performance and teaching methods

Politics - used to analyze public opinion and election results

Finance - used to analyze market trends and investment opportunities

Types of Bias

Selection Bias - when the sample is not representative of the population

Response Bias - when respondents provide inaccurate answers

Non-response Bias - when those who do not respond differ from those who do

Survivorship Bias - when only those who 'survived' a process are included in the analysis

Sampling Methods

Simple Random Sampling - every member of the population has an equal chance of being selected

Systematic Sampling - selecting every kth member of the population

Stratified Sampling - dividing the population into strata and sampling from each

Cluster Sampling - dividing the population into clusters and sampling from one or more clusters

Convenience Sampling - selecting members of the population who are easy to reach

Voluntary Response Sampling - selecting members of the population who volunteer to participate

Quota Sampling - selecting members of the population based on certain characteristics

Judgment Sampling - selecting members of the population based on the researcher's judgment

Measures of Dispersion

Range - the difference between the highest and lowest values

Interquartile Range (IQR) - the range between the first and third quartiles

Standard Deviation - a measure of the spread of the data

Variance - the square of the standard deviation

Coefficient of Variation - a measure of relative variability

Systematic Sampling

To find the interval - divide the population size by the sample size

Example: Population = 100, Sample = 10, Interval = 10

Simple Random Sampling

Every member of the population has an equal chance of being selected

Methods: Lottery, Random Number Generator

Stratified Sampling

Dividing the population into strata and sampling from each

Example: Sampling by gender, age, or income

Cluster Sampling

Dividing the population into clusters and sampling from one or more clusters

Example: Sampling by school, hospital, or neighborhood

Convenience Sampling

Selecting members of the population who are easy to reach

Example: Sampling at a shopping center or bus stop

Voluntary Response Sampling

Selecting members of the population who volunteer to participate

Example: Sampling on a survey website or in a public place

Measures of Central Tendency

Mean - the average of all values

Median - the middle value when data is ordered

Mode - the most frequent value

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Method	Advantages	Disadvantages
Simple Random Sampling	Every member has an equal chance of being selected	Can be time-consuming and expensive
Systematic Sampling	Easy to implement and ensures coverage of the population	May introduce bias if there is a pattern in the population
Stratified Sampling	Ensures representation of all groups in the population	Requires knowledge of the population structure
Cluster Sampling	Easy to implement and reduces costs	May introduce bias if clusters are not homogeneous
Convenience Sampling	Quick and easy to implement	Not representative of the population
Voluntary Response Sampling	Easy to implement and low cost	Not representative of the population
Quota Sampling	Easy to implement and ensures coverage of the population	May introduce bias if quotas are not carefully monitored
Judgment Sampling	Easy to implement and ensures coverage of the population	May introduce bias if the researcher's judgment is biased

Measures of Central Tendency/Averages

Mode - most frequent value

Median - middle value when data is ordered

Mean - average of all values

Range - difference between highest and lowest values

IQR - difference between first and third quartiles

Standard Deviation - measure of spread

Variance - square of standard deviation

Coefficient of Variation - relative variability
