Helena Gutteridge was a socialist and feminist whose vision helped to shape social reform legislation in British Columbia in

the first decades of the twentieth century and also one of the first women there to hold high political office She was born in England in 1879 A militant suffragist tutored by the Pankhursts she learned the politics of confrontation early Emigrating to Vancouver in 1911 she found the suffrage movement there too polite and organized the B C Woman s Suffrage League to help working women fight for the vote And she kept on organizing As a journeyman tailor she was a power in her union local and as the only woman on the Vancouver Trades and Labor Council their rebel girl she championed the rights of workers and organized women to fight for themselves In the 1930s as a member of the feisty new political movement the Co operative Commonwealth Federation she joined in the struggles of the unemployed for work and wages Then in 1937 as the first woman ever elected to Vancouver City Council she led the fight for low income housing As was typical for women of her class and time Helena did not keep personal records nor did organizational records exist to any extent Irene Howard made it her task over a period of years to search out and assemble details of Helena s life and career and to interview old comrades who knew Helena and the turbulent times in which she lived Herself a miner s daughter the author brings to her subject an affectionate regard and sympathy qualified by the larger view of the scholar and researcher The result is a lively biography shot through with humour and pathos that pays homage to Helena Gutteridge and to many of the people who have been inspired by a cause and who have taught us about the politics of caring

American Woman Suffrage Postcards Kenneth Florey, 2016-04-29 American women s suffrage activists were fascinated with suffrage themed postcards They collected them exchanged them wrote about them used them as fundraisers and organized postcard day campaigns The cards they produced were imaginative and ideological advancing arguments for the enfranchisement of women and responding to antisuffrage broadsides Commercial publishers were also interested in suffrage cards recognizing their profit potential Their products though were reactive rather than proactive conveying stereotypes they assumed reflected public attitudes often negative towards the movement Cataloging approximately 700 examples this study examines the visual rhetoric of suffrage postcards in the context of the movement itself and as part of the general history of postcards

The Women's Suffrage Movement in Britain, 1866-1928 S. van Wingerden, 2016-07-27 This book tells the story of the women s suffrage movement in Britain

beginning with John Stuart Mill's proposal of a women's suffrage amendment to a reform bill. It ends with the victory of 1928 concluding more than 50 years of repeated defeats, anti-suffragism, militancy, imprisonment, hunger strikes, and forcible feeding, and multiple internal splits, and their only partial victory of 1918. It is not intended to break new ground in academia but to provide an introduction to the general reader that covers the entire relevant time period and introduces major themes and issues.

Indian Suffragettes Sumita Mukherjee, 2018-04-16 Popular depictions of campaigns for women's suffrage in films and literature have invariably focused on Western suffrage movements. The fact that Indian women built up a vibrant suffrage movement in the twentieth century has been largely neglected.
