Character	Importance
Myth	A traditional story created to explain the origins of values, the physical world, fate, nature and create role models.
Gaia	Came from Chaos, Mother Earth, creator of the Titans
Uranus	Gaia's mate, father of the sky and Heavens, together created the Titans
Kronos	The ruling Titan, overthrew Uranus, swallowed his children to preserve his power, created the Olympians
Rhea	Wife of Kronos, created the Olympians, convinced her children to overthrow their father Kronos
Zeus	supreme ruler, god of the sky, lightening & thunder, symbol was a thunderbolt
Hera	Married to Zeus, queen of the gods, ruler of marriage, associated with the peacock
Poseidon	god of the sea, earthquakes, horses, symbol was the trident
Hades	god of the Underworld and ruler of the dead, symbol was a pitchfork
Demeter	goddess of growing things, harvest, farming, grain, & mother to Persephone
Hestia	goddess of the hearth and order in relationships
Athena	goddess wisdom, justice, war & peace, most loved goddess, associated with the story of Arachne
Artemis	twin sister of Apollo, goddess of woods, moon, hunting, wild animals, and childbirth
Apollo	twin brother of Artemis, god of the sun, the arts, & medicine
Dionysus	born of Zeus & a mortal mother, god of revelry & the grapevine, very popular god
