MONO VS POLY

- Monotheists believe that a sole Supreme Being exists and do not believe that there are multiple gods (Cataldo, 2020).
- Polytheists may revere numerous gods or spirits and often practice rituals to pay homage to different deities for different reasons.

EXAMPLES

- Christianity: Christianity worships one God and follows the teachings of Jesus Christ. This faith is based on the Bible, which teaches about one God and recounts the life of Jesus.
- Islam: The Islamic faith centers around Allah, the all-knowing deity revealed through Muhammed's teachings.
