

The Not-So-Happy Ending

The wedding day, for most individuals, is one of the happiest and most memorable days of their life. But unfortunately for some people, this day can be the day that they dread the most. With no preparation or expectation, young children are expected to marry around the age at which puberty occurs. Most of us get the choice to choose our life companion and how we wish to live our lives. Accompanied with information from credible sources, as well as a heartfelt interview with my grandmother, it is clear that child marriage was always, and will continue to be a negative aspect of society. Although it is a way of life in many regions, child marriages prove to be unbeneficial and harmful. This is because it is illegal and morally wrong. Consequently, child marriage degrades millions of women's lives around the world.

Child marriage is a formal marriage or informal union, where one or both people are under the age of eighteen. Marriage is usually between two individuals who have both consented. But unfortunately, in several countries, the only consent that seems to matter is the person's parents. The child has no say. They are then forcibly joined with another person, who is much older many times, and then married. This problem must be addressed because it brings no benefit to the individuals involved. Many believe that this does not occur very often, but to the contrary, it happens beyond reason. According to Girls Not Brides, a nonprofit organization, twelve million children around the world are annually victims of this crime (Par. 1). The top three countries in which this is a common practice are Bangladesh, India, and Nepal. In these countries, there is a law against child marriage, but it is making no impact on the actions of these people.

I spoke with my own grandmother (who resides in Bharatpur, Nepal) over the topic. I asked her about her experience of getting married as a young girl at the age of thirteen. She strongly recalled the day as she spoke: "[translated from Nepali] I was thirteen years old when my parents organized my wedding. Everyone in the community would get married young, so I did not think it was odd. I do admit that maybe I may have not had chances to progress my life professionally, but it is what it is. My in-laws and your grandfather were not cruel to me, for which I am thankful, as I had heard stories earlier around the town of girls being not being treated well after marriage. I have led a comfortable life, but I know that many of my neighbors did not. As you [Nia] bring it up, I can say with confidence that getting married so young is not promoted in my books." After I ended the call with her, things became even more clear. No abuse would take place only if the young girl-bride was lucky. My grandmother did say something that took me by surprise. Many of the girls in the community already knew that they were bound to be married at a young age. Young women were betrothed in their early teens, and that was the norm which was accepted.
