After the study was underway, Congress passed the National Aeronautics and Space Administration Transition Authorization Act of 2017, which called for NASA to engage the National Academies in a review of NASA's Mars Exploration Program. NASA and the Academies agreed to incorporate that review into the midterm study. That study has produced this report, which serves as a midterm assessment and provides guidance on achieving the goals in the remaining years covered by the decadal survey, as well as preparing for the next decadal survey, currently scheduled to begin in 2020.
