Topic: What invention and inventor has had the biggest impact on your life today? **Purpose:**

- To inform: give information about your chosen person, summarizing factual information from a variety of sources.
- To analyze: evaluate the research and present your conclusions. The
 research you include from other sources in your paper should support
 your conclusion that the inventor you have chosen is relevant to
 today's world. It is important to remember that this is not a paper
 where you have room to include your own opinions, particularly if
 they are not based on research. Even if you know something about
 your topic, you must back it up with the research found in your
 sources.
- To persuade: write in such a way that you convince your audience that your invention and inventor is significant to your life today.

Audience: your peers and teacher. Even though you are addressing your peers, you must use formal language. Slang and contractions are NOT allowed.

Point of View: Third person. Do not use any 1st or 2std person pronouns such as "I" or "you". Instead, write in an objective format. For example: Instead of saying, "I believe the inventor and invention that has the biggest impact on my life today is...." Use this, "The inventor and invention that has the biggest impact on middle school students is..."

Length: Five (5) paragraphs of at least 5 - 7 sentences @ paragraph (not counting your Works Cited page)
