

threat to society as these citizens become enemies of the state. With more non-conventional threats in cyber-security and online warfare with terror groups, it is even more imperative to allow surveillance of the private lives of citizens. This empowers the state to pre-emptively isolate and diffuse any threats to our society. In exchange for greater surveillance, we can enjoy a secure state and more rights.

The state should also be allowed to interfere in the private lives of individuals to protect the economic welfare of the country and its citizens. With a more vocal and educated population, more citizens are rejecting a paternalistic government that interferes in their economic decisions. This is seen in Singapore with the popularisation of the slogan 'Return Our CPF' on social media. However, in the context of a rapidly aging population, more countries are directly mandating personal economic decisions. While the Singapore government has allowed more freedom in usage of the Central Provident Fund (CPF), the continuance of this scheme shows how such interference is key in ensuring Singapore's long-term economic sustainability where its citizens are self-sufficient. Even the US government which claims to be a bastion for freedom dictates the economic decision of its citizens and continues to implement unpopular initiatives such as Obamacare which requires every citizen to purchase health insurance. As much as such actions attenuate an individual's free choice, they are justified as the state possesses ample resources to address up and coming issues such as income inequality that individuals are incapable of solving alone. Although individuals undoubtedly hold a stake in this matter, they might not possess the know-how sufficient to overcome these problems, seen in the presence of inter-generational inequity. Thus, the state's interference is arguably necessary to secure the economic welfare of its citizens.

In light of existing tyrannical regimes, where governments ruthlessly sacrifice their people to promote their self-interests, interference by the state is not desired as such interference leads to a slippery slope where the rights of individuals are eroded. The state could potentially devolve into an authoritarian one where individuals have no political voice. This is seen in countries such as North Korea where the government vociferously clamps down on its citizens through fear and repression to selfishly indulge the whims and fancies of the Kim Family. Thus, allowing unlimited interference without any checks and balances could unleash Pandora's Box where governments would be allowed to interfere in all aspects of citizens' lives. This asymmetry in power has fatal effects, that would bring a society to its knees.

With the rise of populist governments that gain support through marginalising certain groups in society, the state should not be allowed to interfere in the private lives of its citizens as it could potentially be harmful to certain groups of people. Rights, such as the freedom of speech and religion are especially crucial to minorities in preventing subjugation by the majority. However, by allowing the state to interfere in private decisions, the minorities may be marginalised and their needs overlooked by the state. For example, the Rohingya Muslims are powerless against the Burman majority government in Myanmar which denies them even basic rights like citizenship or freedom to reproduce. Without rights to serve as an effective check and balance, minorities will be disenfranchised and excluded from political processes. This ultimately institutionalises discrimination and causes long-term injustice and inequality.
