The leadership styles which are comprised of transformational transactional and passive avoidant were measured by the Multifactor Leadership Questionnaire MLQ 5X Bass Avolio 1995 The emotional intelligence components which are comprised of perception of emotion managing own emotions managing others emotions and utilization of emotion were measured by the Schutte Self Report Emotional Intelligence Test SSEIT Schutte et al 2009 The demographic areas controlled in this study include gender age ethnicity education and tenure Multiple regression was conducted on each of the seven hypotheses in this study and it was determined that transformational leadership style and transactional leadership style were predictors of perception of emotion managing others emotions and utilization of emotion This study also revealed that transformational leadership style was a predictor of managing own emotions Surprisingly transactional leadership style was not a predictor of managing own emotions As expected there was no significant correlation discovered between passive avoidant leadership style and emotional intelligence Furthermore the results showed that emotional intelligence was a predictor of both transformational and transactional leadership styles This study discovered that gender was a significant variable and females scored higher than males in the emotional intelligence component of managing others emotions The findings in this study coincide with the body of literature that exists which revealed positive relationships between emotional intelligence components and transformational and transactional leadership styles
