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The researcher describes a virtuous person as one “who acts and feels as he or she should, for the right reason considering the circumstances” (Alvaro 770).

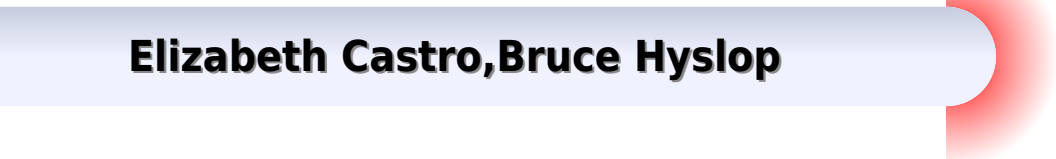
