Introduction

At the same time, the fact that these children will still be slaughtered a bit later in life does not deserve Swift's critical remarks and gets ignored. Such decisions reveal his ability to place accents wisely and stop reviewing the proposal's implications when necessary. Technically, the rich purchasing low-income children as their livestock should also be condemned for taking human lives away, but
