1. Section 4.1: Force
 - A. Definition: Force is that cause of an acceleration or that change in an object's velocity.
 - B. A force can be a push, or pull, and pressure. Force can act directly through physical contact or as a distance (or a magnetic) force.
 - C. Its measure is in **NEWTONS**.

A newton is the force needed to accelerate a 1 kilogram mass by 1 meter per second squared

$$1\text{N} = 1\text{kg} \times 1\text{m/s}^2$$

12. Section 4.2: NOT worth an weight or mass!
13. Weight: When you weigh is a measure of your mass on the planet earth. Your weight can change (evidence for your surroundings). Ex: When standing 1000 pounds on earth, but on the moon that weight only 16 pounds!
14. When your weight can change your mass is constant regardless of your surroundings. 1000 lbs on the planet earth weight 100 pounds on the moon! Ex: 1000 pounds on the earth, 100 pounds on the moon!
15. Section 4.3: a measure of force, the unit our teachers for students have since that grade is newtons not your body (your weight). Ex: students are made and have!
16. Conversion Factors:

$$1 \text{ pound} = 4.448 \text{ newtons}$$

$$1 \text{ newton} = 0.225 \text{ pounds}$$

 1. Contact Forces: The force that acts from the physical contact of two objects.
