    - i. Nature outside of us (earthquakes, epidemics...)
    - ii. Nature inside us (bodies become weaker)
    - iii. Fellow human beings (not always treated nicely)
  - Adults create god to take place of parents and take away anxieties
- Freud raises question of whether it is being correctly interpreted and whether it ought to be regarded as the fons et origo of the whole need for religion.
  - Where does this common feeling come from
- Towards the outside, ego maintains clear lines of demarcation (I know what's me and I know what's not)
  - There is one state, an unusual state, in which it does not do this being in love
  - Declaring love "I" and "you" = one, prepared to behave as if it were fact
- There are cases in which parts of a persons own body, perceptions, thoughts and feelings seem alien to him and as not belonging to his ego
  - Other cases in which he ascribes to the external world things that clearly originate in his own ego
