However many manuscripts are rejected or sent back for major reworking not because the science they contain is in any way bad but because the same problems keep occurring in the way that the material is presented. It is one thing to write a good scientific paper however it is quite another thing to get it published. This requires some additional nous. In writing this book Don Harris draws upon nearly a quarter of a century of experience as an author and reviewer of research papers and ultimately as a journal editor. By his own admission it contains all the things he wished that his mentors had told him 25 years ago but didn't.
