2. The Second Industrial Revolution: Population and Progressivism

- a. What caused the Second Industrial Revolution to start? Discuss how the business took control of not only the economy but federal, state and local politics, national ideas, social movements, agriculture.
- b. The primary goal was showing that Second Industrial Revolution was an achievement that the social problems in America required the nation and caused the religious, ethnic ethnic movements.
- c. Describe the rise of Progressivism, discussing at least three different reform movements. Discuss the leaders and major legislative acts? How did change and reform come? The reform movements in America have the temperance, women's suffrage, children's issues, the 17th direct movements, Progressivism, the Chicago's labor regulation 1894 law, food, an women's labor, children labor
