Lieutenant Colonel OLINTO M. BARSANTI, 034037, General Staff Corps, United States Army, as the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-1, of the Advance Command Post of General Headquarters. during the period 27 June to 12 July 1950, was responsible for setting up the entire administrative organization of the headquarters for the Advance Command Post and United States Army in Korea including Korea Military Advisory Group, Unassisted. except for indigenous personnel, he was successful in establishing all necessary systems and facilities for administration, receipt of replacements, care of prisoners of war, mess, billeting, and transportation; as well as strength and casualty reporting systems. In addition to performing all G-1 administration duties, he spent long and arduous hours canvassing the entire area from the Han River to Suwon in an effort to assist reorganization of the forces of the Republic of South Korea. By his tireless efforts and devotion to duty he contributed in an outstanding degree to the mission of the United Nations in Korea.
