Do's:

- Select a term that is not only clear but also relevant to your essay's context.
- Clearly establish the boundaries of the term, specifying what is included and excluded.
- Use descriptive language and vivid imagery to bring the definition to life.
- Investigate the origins and how the definition may have evolved over time.
- Prompt readers to think critically by presenting thought-provoking aspects of the term.

Don'ts:

- Steer clear of terms with ambiguous meanings that could lead to confusion.
- Don't neglect thorough research on the term's historical and cultural context.
- Avoid excessive use of technical or specialized language that may alienate readers.
- Don't overlook subtle nuances; explore the depth of the term beyond a superficial level.
- Don't assume everyone shares the same understanding; provide ample context for clarity.
