1. **Title:** Come up with a contextually sufficient title that reflects the core purpose of your report
2. **Introduction:**
 - 2.1 Briefly provide necessary background information
 - 2.2 Discuss the summary of your experiment
3. **Hypothesis:** State your hypotheses
4. **Materials:** Comprehensively go through the list of main materials leveraged in your experiment
5. **Procedures:**
 - 5.1 Describe and explain the methodology you employed
 - 5.2 Discuss carried out procedures in detail
6. **Data:** Show graphs, tables, and figures of all important observations
7. **Analysis:**
 - 7.1. Convey an extensive analysis based on your evidence
 - 7.2. Demonstrate all important calculations and formulas
 - 7.3. Mention possible sources of error
8. **Discussion:** Evaluate and expound on the key outcomes of your experiment
9. **Conclusion:**
 - 9.1. Restate your objective and hypothesis and answer if they were met/supported
 - 9.2. Lay proper foundation for further research in your field
