It then presents the following key design principles to be considered in the development arsenic mitigation strategies: inform affected people and other stakeholders in a timely fashion; take immediate steps to determine the extent and seriousness of the problem through testing; prepare separate, but compatible, emergency and long-term programme phases; prioritise reductions in arsenic intake, even if standards are not met immediately; involve all relevant sectors in a coordinated mitigation programme; involve other stakeholders in a multi-partner effort; and recognize uncertainty by using flexible programme designs.

The chapter goes on to present a series of case studies on responses to arsenic contamination of water supplies in middle- and low-income countries. The objective of the case studies is to illustrate the application of design parameters in different geographic and socio-economic contexts. The discussion concludes with a brief review of the key design principals specific to arsenic mitigation programming.
