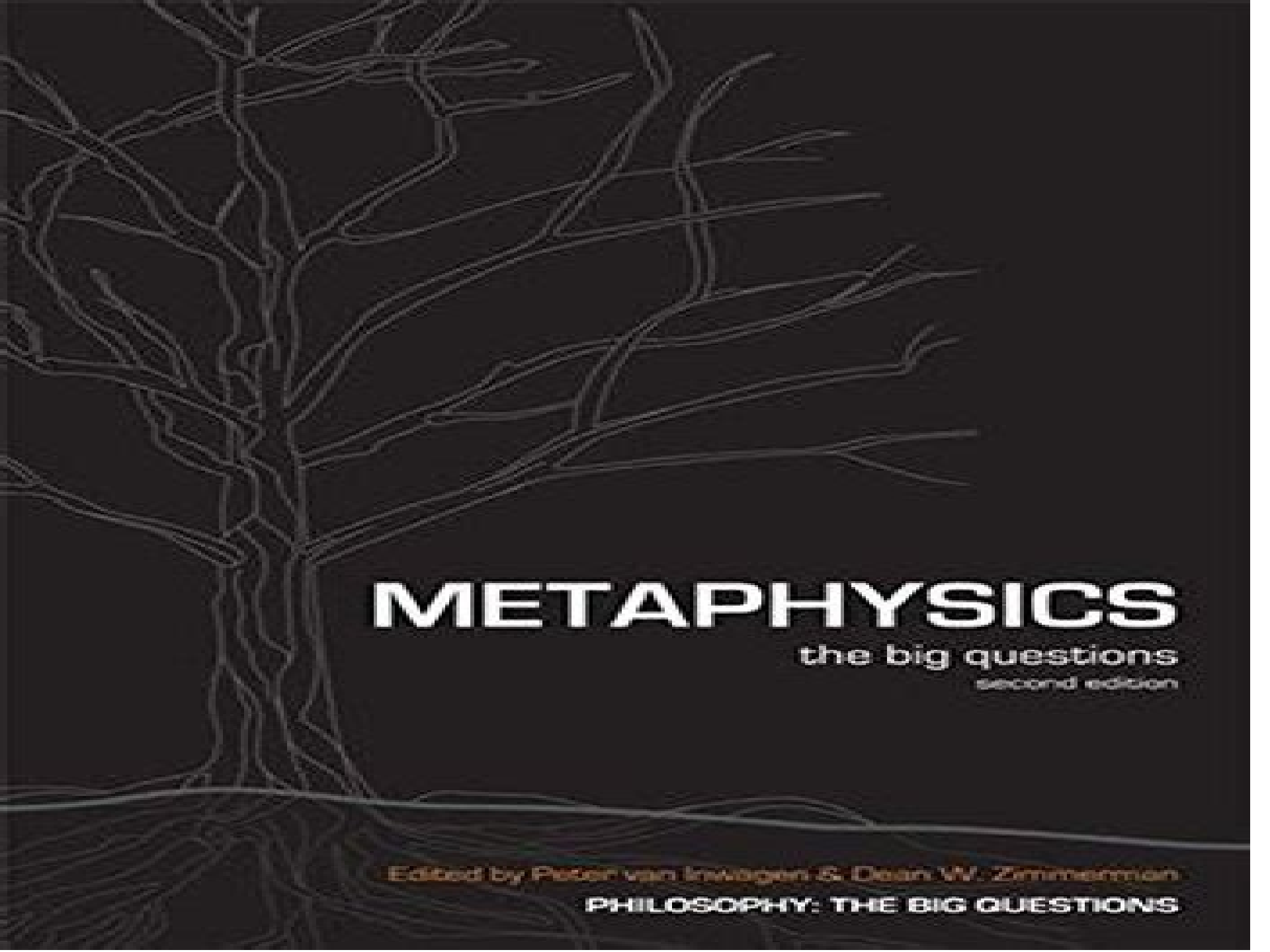

Rae, 2024-06-06 This volume attempts to show why ontology matters for a proper grasp of issues in bioethics Contemporary discussions on bioethics often focus on seeking solutions for a wide range of issues that revolve around persons The issues in question are multi layered involving such diverse aspects as the metaphysical ontological personal medical moral legal cultural social political religious and environmental In navigating through such a complex web of issues it has been said that the central problems philosophers and bioethicists face are ethical in nature In this regard biomedical sciences and technological breakthroughs take a leading role in terms of shaping the sorts of questions that give rise to ethical problems For example is it ethical to keep terminally ill patients alive on dialysis machines or artificial ventilators Is it ethical to take someone s vital organs upon death and transplant them into another person s body without any prior consent from the deceased person Reproductive techniques also raise complicated ethical issues involving in vitro fertilization contraceptives prenatal testing abortions and genetic enhancements Moreover biomedical issues raise ethical problems regarding research on human subjects stem cell research and enhancement biotechnology The beginning and end of life issues bring up their own complicated ethical conundrums involving among other things terminating life support and euthanasia This book approaches such complex bioethical questions by engaging in ground level debates about the ontology

of persons This is a nonnegotiable first step in taking steps forward in seeking a plausible solution s for the complex ethical problems in bioethics

Buford, 2011-11-25 *Know Thyself* An Essay in Social Personalism proposes that social Personalism can best provide for self knowledge In the West self knowledge has been sought within the framework of two dominant intellectual traditions order and the emerging self On the one hand ancient and medieval philosophers living in an orderly hierarchical society governed by honor and shame and bolstered by the metaphysics of being and rationalism believed persons gain self knowledge through uniting with the ground of their being once united they would understand what they are what they are to

be and what they are to do On the other hand Renaissance and modern thinkers such as Pico della Mirandola Copernicus Descartes Locke and Kant shattered the great achievement of the high middle ages and bequeathed to posterity an emerging self in a splintered world Continuing their search for self knowledge the moderns found themselves faced with the dualism of the emerging self of the Renaissance and the natural world as understood by modern scientists New problems spun out of this dualism including the mind body problem the other minds problem free will and determinism the nature and possibility of social relationships values moral norms and their relationship to the natural and social worlds and the relationships between science and religion Finding self knowledge among these splinters without a guiding orientation has proven difficult Even though luminaries such as Spinoza Berkeley and Hegel attempted to bring order to the sundered elements their attempts proved unsatisfactory We contend that neither order nor the emerging self can adequately provide for self knowledge Since those culturally embodied master narratives lead us to an impasse we turn to social Personalism Self knowledge developed in this book shows how persons in relation to the Personal learn who they are what they are to become and what they must do to achieve that goal It also shows that the achievement of self knowledge is supported by a natural social and cultural environment rooted in trust In this humane and timely discussion Thomas O Buford offers a personalist understanding of self knowledge that avoids the impersonalisms that erode the dignity of persons and their moral life which characterize modern life

Problems from Reid James Van Cleve, 2015-08-03 James Van Cleve here shows why Thomas Reid 1710-96 deserves a place alongside the other canonical figures of modern philosophy He expounds Reid's positions and arguments on a wide range of topics taking interpretive stands on points where his meaning is disputed and assessing the value of his contributions to issues philosophers are discussing today Among the topics Van Cleve explores are Reid's account of perception and its relation to sensation conception and belief his nativist account of the origin of the concepts of space and power his attempt to clear the way for the belief that the things we directly perceive are external things not ideas in our minds his stand on the distinction between primary and secondary qualities his account of acquired perception whereby we come to stand in a quasi perceptual relation to qualities not originally perceived his claim that visual space is non-Euclidean his answers to the questions why we see the world right side up with inverted retinal images and whether a newly sighted person would recognize by sight the shapes he previously knew by touch whether memory like perception is a form of direct awareness and how we manage to conceive of things that are utterly nonexistent Also examined are Reid's account of human knowledge by means of first principles his externalist reply to philosophical skepticism his volitional theory of action his use of the distinction between event causation and agent causation to understand freedom of the will and his criticism of Hume and anticipation of Moore on the analysis of moral judgment The most comprehensive work on Reid in a quarter century this book will be welcomed by students of early modern philosophy epistemology the philosophy of perception and the philosophy of action

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
