The dots are embossed on thick paper and each can be raised or flat i e present or absent Each dot is therefore equivalent to one bit of information As a result the Braille code Figure 1 is a 6 bit code and can therefore represent 64 symbols the code of six flat dots indicates a blank space Braille's followers extended the capabilities of his code in several ways One important extension is contractions.
