15 Neither doe men light a candle, and put it vnder a bushell : but on a candlesticke, and it giueth light vnto all that are in the house.

16 Let your light so shine before men, * that they may see your good workes, and glorifie your father which is in heauen.

17 ¶ Thinke not that I am come to destroy the lawe or the Prophets. I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill.

18 For verily I say vnto you, * Till heauen and earth passe, one iote or one tittle, shall in no wise passe from the law, till all be fulfilled.

19 * Whosoever therefore shall breake one of these least commandements, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdome of heauen: but whosoever shall doe, and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdome of heauen.

20 For I say vnto you, That except your righteousnesse shall exceede the righteousnesse of the Scribes and Pharisees, yee shall in no case enter into the kingdome of heauen.

30 And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast it from thee. For it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell.

33 ¶ Againe, yee haue heard that it hath bene said by them of old time, * Thou shalt not forswear thy selfe, but shalt performe vnto the Lord thine othes.

34 But I say vnto you, Swear not at all, neither by heauen, for it is Gods throne:

35 Nor by the earth, for it is his footstool: neither by Hierusalem, for it is the citie of the great king.

36 Neither shalt thou sweare by thy head, because thou canst not make one haire white or blacke.

37 * But let your communication bee Yea, yea: Nay, nay: for whatsoever is more then these, commeth of euill.
