The HEP theory claims that humans are such a uniquely superior species that they are exempt from environmental forces. This, as demonstrated through the industry practices by Monstano and others, is a key component in Food Inc. The belief that Humans had the capacity to accumulate and innovate, therefore making us capable of solving all-natural problems. This theory states that while the earth has a finite level of natural resources and waste repositories, the innovative capacity of humans will prevail. Further, the theory states that growth in production will in fact lead to a growth in consumption.
