Chapter Four on *Dial M for Murder* (1954) returns to Homer's *Odyssey* in the interpretive use of the lay of Demodocus, a story about the sexual triangle of Hephaestus, Aphrodite, and Ares. Chapter Five on *Rear Window* (1954) finds its narrative archetype in The Homeric Hymn to Aphrodite, the erotic theme of Sirius the Dog Star, also marks the film. Chapter Six on *To Catch a Thief* (1955) offers the opportunity to break from mythic analogues and to consider the film's philosophical resonances, Plato and Epicurus in the context of motifs coalesced around the god Dionysus/Bacchus.
