

There s also a gorgeous silhouetted telling of Jabberwocky and Mahendra s Singh s surrealistic take on The Hunting of the Snark Curveballs in this volume include fairy tales illustrated by the untameable S Clay Wilson a fiery speech from freed slave Frederick Douglass rendered in stark black and white by Seth Tobocman a letter on reincarnation from Flaubert the Victorian erotic classic Venus in Furs the drug classic The Hasheesh Eater and silk screened illustrations for the ghostly children s classic Der Struwwelpeter Among many other canonical works **Once Upon a Time . . .
