## HEALTH ASSESSMENT

### 1. What is a bruit? What does it sound like?

- **Bruit** — is an audible vascular sound associated with turbulent blood flow
  - blowing, swishing sound indicating blood flow turbulence **commonly heard in arteries**
  - found in **carotid** and **heart**

### 2. What is a murmur? What is a palpable murmur?

- **Murmur** — **flowing, swishing sound** that occurs with **turbulent blood flow** in the **heart** or **great vessels**, and/or **heart valves**
  - **“Systolic”**
  - **[murmurs of normal heart]** — can be due to fever, exertion, pregnancy, hyperthyroidism
  - **[murmurs of valvular heart disease]** — heart valve stenosis (narrowed), regurgitation (leaky)
- **Palpable murmur**
  - Always indicates an organic defect
  - The area where the thrill is felt strongest gives clue to etiology of the thrill and may be:
    - **Systolic murmur** — heard between S<sub>1</sub> and S<sub>2</sub>
    - **Diastolic murmur** — heard between S<sub>2</sub> and S<sub>1</sub>

### 3. What is Virchow's Triad?

- **Virchow's Triad** — consist of **3 blood components** that contribute to **Deep Vein Thromboses**
  - **Stasis** — blood not moving, sitting in one place
  - **Hypercoagulability**
  - **Endothelial damage** — damage of vessels walls of the vein
- **Deep Vein Thromboses**
  - Pain, swelling, redness, warmth
  - **Homan's Sign**



### 4. What is Homan's sign?

- **Homan's sign** — test for DVT
  - **Pain in the calf** when **foot dorsiflexed** is a positive Homan's sign

### 5. What is paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnea (PND)? Look in your textbook.

- **Paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnea (PND)**
  - sensation of shortness of breath that awakens the patient, often after 1 – 2 hours of sleep
  - relieved in the upright position

### 6. Describe age related changes of the cardiovascular system.

- **Possible increased risk with chronic HTN** → **myocardium becomes less elastic**
- **valves calcify/thicken**
- **↓ Rest** & **↑ R-R CO** during exercise (30 – 40%)
- **↓** ability of the heart to augment CO
- **↑ stroke volume** (stroke fibrillations) are common
- **↓** tolerance of tachycardia
