Les Métamorphoses Du Monde Associatif:

Les métamorphoses du monde associatif Matthieu Hély, 2009 Fort d'un nombre de salariés équivalents aux effectifs de la fonction publique territoriale aux statuts multiples auxquels s'ajoutent 14 millions de bénévoles mais aussi des volontaires et des stagiaires le monde associatif est devenu un véritable marché du travail. Pourtant dans les représentations collectives ce monde demeure consacré comme celui du bénévolat au don de soi et l'engagement citoyen. Loin d'être un monde hors du monde il cristallise les grandes transformations qui caractérisent la société salariale d'une part il est le lieu de luttes de classement dans la définition des frontières entre secteur marchand et secteur non marchand. De l'autre il mêle des pratiques que la société reconnaît comme relevant de la sphère productive puisqu'elles sont intégrées au salariat des prestations réalisées dans le cadre du bénévolat et du volontariat. En ce sens il interroge les catégories traditionnelles du travail. Cet ouvrage montre ainsi que la catégorie des travailleurs associatifs constitue désormais une fraction du salariat que l'on ne peut plus ignorer. Car l'explosion du travail associatif ne peut être interprétée en dehors des mutations de la fonction publique tout simplement parce que ce travail incarne une forme alternative de service de l'intérêt général. De fait le salariat dans le secteur associatif représente une alternative de plus en plus sérieuse à la rarefaction des postes de fonctionnaires en particulier pour les jeunes sortants de formation qui en d'autres temps se seraient destinés à servir la collectivité en intégrant la fonction publique.

The French Nonprofit Sector Laura Nirello, Lionel Prouteau, 2018-08-20 This article deals with the literature on the French nonprofit sector. A preliminary part is devoted to presenting and discussing the characteristics that shape the approaches to this sector in France. We stress the strong influence of legal categories on the sector's definition and in this context the importance of the status inherited from the 1901 Act on contracts of association. This raises a problem for a more analytical approach to the sector because the diversity of the nonprofit organizations (NPOs) regulated under this Act risks being overshadowed. In this first part we also underline the primacy accorded in France to the concept of the social economy which has today become the social and solidarity economy (SSE) over that of the nonprofit sector. In the second part the article outlines some landmarks in the history of the French NPS. French NPOs were for many years objects of suspicion, arbitrariness and repression on the part of the public authorities and this persisted until the 1901 legislation on contracts of association was enacted. However this hostile context did not prevent the sector from having a richer existence than is sometimes admitted. This literature review also focuses on empirical studies of the sector placing a particular emphasis on the more recent ones. These French studies basically adopt two types of approach. The first is concerned essentially with the NPOs and focuses its attention on their economic importance whether measured in terms of financial resources, employment or less frequently added value. The second approach investigates the kinds of individual participation the sector engenders by examining the various forms it takes such as membership of NPOs or voluntary work. This review ends with the analysis of the challenges that NPS faces in a context characterized by the increasing constraints on public funding, changes in the
