
# Rainbow Bluet

Enallagma antennatum 1–1¼" (27–32mm) Wingspan 1¼–1%" (32–42mm)

RANGE Ontario; Montana south to Colorado and east to Quebec and Virginia.

These damselflies prefer open, sunny areas with light to moderate plant cover. The males in particular are very colorful: black with tones of blue, green, yellow, and orange: females are paler but still colorful. Rainbow bluets are found during summer near slow-moving waters, from brooks to large rivers. They also inhabit the inlets and outlets of small lakes, the edges of larger lakes, and gravel pits, marshes, and reservoirs. The long-legged, greenish larvae climb up the stems of aquatic plants, where they wait to ambush small insect prey. Some scientists believe that rainbow bluet is the oldest and most primitive of the bluets. ALSO CALLED Orange-faced bluet.



## Familiar Bluet

RANGE Southern Canada, most of United States, and south into Mexico.

The genus Enallagma includes some of North America's largest and bluest damselflies, hence the common collective name "bluets." There are 35 species found in the U.S. and Canada, many of which are a challenge to identify to species. Familiar bluets live in a wide variety of habitats; they can be found near small, slow-moving streams, ponds, small lakes, and ditches and sometimes also in brackish wetlands. Adults are active from late spring through fall in most of range, year-round in Florida. They forage for small insects in fields, sometimes gleaning prey perched on vegetation; they are also cannibalistic. Females walk down stems to lay their eggs underwater, while the males remain perched above, on guard.
