its growth was slower than that of the BBC and it took until 1962 to complete the network across the UK Once it had arrived however its impact was considerable The book will provide an historical narrative and critical analysis of independent television ITV in Wales from 1958 up until the present day Baseball's Pivotal Era, 1945-1951 William Marshall, 2021-11-21 With personal interviews of players and owners and with over two decades of research in newspapers and archives Bill Marshall tells of the players the pennant races and the officials who shaped one of the most memorable eras in sports and American history At the end of World War II soldiers returning from overseas hungered to resume their love affair with baseball Spectators still identified with players whose salaries and off season employment as postmen plumbers farmers and insurance salesmen resembled their own It was a time when kids played baseball on sandlots and in pastures fans followed the game on the radio and tickets were affordable The outstanding play of Joe DiMaggio Stan Musial Ted Williams Bob Feller Don Newcombe Warren Spahn and many others dominated the field But perhaps no performance was more important than that of Jackie Robinson whose entrance into the game broke the color barrier won him the respect of millions of Americans and helped set the stage for the civil rights movement Baseball's Pivotal Era 1945 1951 also records the attempt to organize the Pittsburgh Pirates and the Mexican League's success in luring players south of the border that led to a series of lawsuits that almost undermined baseball s reserve clause and antitrust exemption The result was spring training pay uniform contracts minimum salary levels player representation and a pension plan the very issues that would divide players and owners almost fifty years later During these years the game was led by A B Happy Chandler a hand shaking speech making singing Kentucky politician Most owners thought he would be easily manipulated unlike baseball s first commissioner the autocratic Judge Kennesaw Mountain Landis Instead Chandler's style led one owner to complain that he was the player's commissioner the fan's commissioner the press and radio commissioner everybody's commissioner but the men who pay him The Policy Makers Anna Kasten Nelson, 2008-12-16 This book is about U S policy makers who have wielded enormous influence largely behind the scenes since the end of World War II The advent of the Cold War brought new problems of national security for the United States As a result U S presidents no longer sat down with their secretaries of state to determine the nation's foreign policy Instead postwar chief executives reached out to individuals in the intelligence and military organizations and increasingly to advisers in the White House The Policy Makers examines seven such advisers from public servants in the state department to CIA directors and U S senators and the policies each adviser influenced By focusing on individuals whose policy making role was often unknown to the public Anna Kasten Nelson and her contributors shed light on the myriad ways in which the postwar foreign policy of the United States has been shaped sometimes in ways very damaging to the nation's security Mission to Mao Sara B. Castro, 2024 In the midst of World War II the United States sent a liaison mission to the headquarters of Chinese Communist forces behind the lines in Yan an China Nicknamed the Dixie Mission for its location in rebel territory it was an interagency delegation that included

intelligence officers from the Office of Strategic Services OSS The intelligence officers were there to gather intelligence that would help the war effort against Japan but interagency and political conflicts erupted over whether or not the mission would expand beyond intelligence collection to operations with the Communists Mission to Mao is a social history of the OSS officers in the field and their clash with political appointees and Washington over the direction of the US relationship with the Chinese Communists The book reveals the attempts of America's inexperienced intelligence officers to improvise operations and to try to define a role for themselves The book takes us beyond the history of China hands versus American anticommunists who backed Chinese Nationalist Chiang Kai shek introducing more nuance Sara B Castro shows how potential benefits for the war effort were thwarted by politicization but she also shows how the OSS officers overreached their authority and suffered from their own biases and blindspots The book draws upon over 14 000 unpublished records from five archives plus numerous published white papers memoirs and scholarly studies to with a focus on the individual American intelligence officers who spent time in Yan an working with Communist leaders **Blacklisted by History** M. charges the matter of leading McCarthy suspect Owen Lattimore the Annie Lee Moss case the Army McCarthy hearings and much more In the end Senator McCarthy was censured by his colleagues and condemned by the press and historians But as Evans writes The real Joe McCarthy has vanished into the mists of fable and recycled error so that it takes the equivalent of a dragnet search to find him Blacklisted by History provides the first accurate account of what McCarthy did and more broadly what happened to America during the Cold War It is a revealing expos of the forces that distorted our national policy in that FDR's Republicans Robert E.
