

At the best I'd suggest making a temporary replacement to get it to someone in a shop who can take a look, if only to confirm it's OK. Battery terminal broke Jul 26, 2022 — If the seller replaces the battery the OP is REALLY lucky. Always a good idea to dry fit battery terminal bolts

to be sure they are correct.
