Prologue

- Why does Ralph fight his battle with Manipulated Light & Power? (7-8)
- Why does Ralph need light? (7)
- What does Ralph mean when he says he is invisible? (11-12) - The answers to this is simultaneously complex and simple. Do yourself the exercise in a manner that respects this paradox.
- How does Ralph see himself? (12)

Chapter 1: The Berlin Room

- Should Ralph accept the world as it is? Why or why not?
- In what ways does the scholarly rig reflect the dream's message that the goal of society is to "keep this raggedary running" (10)?
 - Consider: "It goes along very fast, some twenty years, all my life I had been looking for something, and everywhere I turned someone threatened me with it was, I accepted that answer too, though there was a difference: the traditional even self-satisfactory I was naive, I was looking for myself and telling everyone except myself questions about it, and only I could answer. I could not find time and much painful bewilderment of the education to achieve a tradition someone else appears to have been fortunate. This man nobody but myself, but then had no answer that I am, amiable man" (10).
- Discuss the meaning of Ralph's words: "here" and "everywhere" and expectations. "There" considered a mere single of desirable conduct – just as my grandfather had been. And what puzzled me was that the did mean had did mean as machinery..." (11-12).

Chapter 2: Trueblood's Case (NOTE: Chapters 2-3 are all a single day during Ralph's junior year in college)

- Why is a life-sized statue more commanding than a man that is alive? (20)

Why Moralize upon It? Brian Danoff, 2020-07-22 Franklin Delano Roosevelt famously declared that the greatest duty of a statesman is to educate The central claim of *Why Moralize upon It* is that it is not only statesmen who can help educate a democratic citizenry but also novelists and filmmakers This book's title is drawn from Melville's *Benito Cereno* Near the end of this novella after he has put down a rebellion of enslaved Africans the American captain Amasa Delano claims that the past is passed and thus there is no need to moralize upon it Melville suggests though that it is crucial for Americans to critically examine American history and American political institutions otherwise they may be blind to the existence of injustices which will ultimately undermine democracy Danoff argues that novels and films play a crucial role in helping democratic citizens undertake the kind of moral reflection that they must engage in if they are to not only preserve their political community but also render it forever worthy of the saving as Abraham Lincoln put it Contending that some of the most profound American thinking about the nature of democratic leadership has come through novels more so than treatises or essays Danoff argues that the works of fiction examined in this book explore difficult questions rather than provide any easy answers Because these works have an ambiguous nuanced and tragic outlook they teach citizen readers how to think through the moral complexities of the political issues on which they

must render judgment The rich and multi faceted democratic education that citizens glean from outstanding works of fiction is particularly necessary at a time when the media landscape is often dominated by superficial viral moments sound bites and social media posts Moreover given that we today live in an era of sharp political polarization in which partisans often demonize one another it is especially valuable for Americans to be exposed to literary and cinematic works of art which remind us that none of us have a monopoly on virtue and that all of us inhabit what Melville called the common continent of men

A Genealogy of Literary Multiculturalism Christopher Douglas,2011-08-15 As an anthropology student studying with Franz Boas Zora Neale Hurston recorded African American folklore in rural central Florida studied hoodoo in New Orleans and voodoo in Haiti talked with the last ex slave to survive the Middle Passage and collected music from Jamaica Her ethnographic work would serve as the basis for her novels and other writings in which she shaped a vision of African American Southern rural folk culture articulated through an antiracist concept of culture championed by Boas culture as plural relative and long lived Meanwhile a very different antiracist model of culture learned from Robert Park s sociology allowed Richard Wright to imagine African American culture in terms of severed traditions marginal consciousness and generation gaps In A Genealogy of Literary Multiculturalism Christopher Douglas uncovers the largely unacknowledged role played by ideas from sociology and anthropology in nourishing the politics and forms of minority writers from diverse backgrounds Douglas divides the history of multicultural writing in the United States into three periods The first which spans the 1920s and 1930s features minority writers such as Hurston and D Arcy McNickle who were indebted to the work of Boas and his attempts to detach culture from race The second period from 1940 to the mid 1960s was a time of assimilation and integration as seen in the work of authors such as Richard Wright Jade Snow Wong John Okada and Ralph Ellison who were influenced by currents in sociological thought The third period focuses on the writers we associate with contemporary literary multiculturalism including Toni Morrison N Scott Momaday Frank Chin Ishmael Reed and Gloria Anzald a Douglas shows that these more recent writers advocated a literary nationalism that was based on a modified Boasian anthropology and that laid the pluralist grounds for our current conception of literary multiculturalism Ultimately Douglas s unified field theory of multicultural literature brings together divergent African American Asian American Mexican American and Native American literary traditions into one story of how we moved from thinking about groups as races to thinking about groups as cultures and then back again

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
