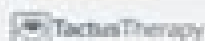

## 5 Common Pitfalls to Avoid When Setting Goals



### 1 Starting too high

When you're just starting out, it's important to set goals that are realistic and achievable. If you set goals that are too high, you may become discouraged and give up.

### 2 Setting goals that are too vague

Consider this: "I want to be better at my job." This is a very vague goal. It doesn't specify what you want to achieve or how you plan to do it.

Use the information you have about your client's strengths and weaknesses to set specific, measurable goals.

### 3 Adding too many goals

Have you ever tried to do too many things at once? It's a common mistake to set too many goals at once. This can lead to feeling overwhelmed and not achieving any of them.

Instead, set a few goals at a time. Focus on one goal at a time and make sure you have the resources and support to achieve it.



## 3 Steps to Setting Goals in Aphasia Therapy

### 1 Get to Know Your Client

Find out about your client's strengths and weaknesses. What are they good at? What are they struggling with? Collaborate with your client to set goals that are meaningful and motivating.

Even if your client is not motivated to set goals, you can help them by setting the example and showing them how to do it.
