

## Preschool Lesson Plan

- 1) **GOALS:** PDM3.4a Coordinates movements to perform more complex tasks.  
PDM3.4b Demonstrates coordination and balance in a variety of activities.
- 2) **Objective:** Students will be able to demonstrate developmentally appropriate coordination and gross motor skills.
- 3) **Materials**
  - a. Hand Drums
  - b. Tapping Sticks
  - c. Blueball- Music Chart- Cycle of Seasons
  - d. Hi-Dee Room- Music Chart- Cycle of Seasons
  - e. Silly Dance Chart- Run-Clap
- 4) **Anticipatory Set:** Ask students to stand in a circle and play Hi-Dee Room. Students will walk, bounce, and fly along with the song. The teacher will sing the song but replace Hi-Dee Room with the children's names. For example, the teacher would sing, Let's all go walking Timothy, Let's all go walking Catherine, Let's all go walking Leah Room, Oh Let's all go walking Scott Room.
- 5) **Teaching Learning Activities**
  - a. **Activity 1**
    - i. Talking Drums
    - ii. Tell the students about the talking drum. The drum makes different noises to give instructions, when it is loud and fast they should run around, when it is slow and quiet they should tip toe, when it is a medium beat they should march, etc. Show the students what each instruction sounds like. Walk around the room beating on the drum and have students follow the drum beats. Every now and then, stop and have them listen.
    - iii. 3-7 minutes
    - iv. Teacher Directed
  - b. **Activity 2**
    - i. Blueball
    - ii. Have the students sit down, cross cross applesauce. Tell them that you are going to give them sticks but they need to stay placed on their knees until the teacher gives them directions. Once they are passed out explain that
