January 7th, 1863.

Dear Elizabeth:

Life at the south has been a nightmare. Our days have been filled with screams and moans of dying men and pain due to the absence of them at home. Yet, I am glad that the war could possibly mean the end of slavery. Ever since the Emancipation Proclamation, a rush of emotional revolution fulfilled me, hence I had the need to share it with you.

No one deserves to be a slave. No race or gender is destined to be used as objects. Not even the wilderness, that has been used by men since the beginning of times for brutal works; cruelty shouldn't be applied to animals either. Slavery is the worst act human kind has ever done; how unsettling it is to see people longing for slavery to be kept. Keeping a slave means tearing apart a family, taking away parents from children, separating lovers, taking apart brothers, part young boys from weeping mothers... Slavery is an act of evil which makes the human race deserve to fall in the flaming pits hell.

After listening to the president, I went out looking for people who felt the emotional revolution too. Most of the doors I knocked on were closed at me, but I did gather a bunch of people. There's still hope for us. We've been helping those that were slaves at their refuges and also to maintain their households. They're victims of war too, therefore not such a title of slavery should be placed upon them. We all are slaves of the evil within men.

I hope this letter makes more than moving your heart. Take power of action in your hands and do what's best for your country. I hope we meet sometime at the end of battle.
