Policies to Support the Development of Indonesia's Manufacturing Sector during 2020-2024 ,2019-01-01 Indonesia s gross domestic product growth rate declined significantly after the Asian financial crisis AFC of 1997 1998 The country s

potential and balance of payments growth rates are only about 5.5% and 3% respectively. One important reason is that the country's industrialization pace declined after the AFC. Today Indonesia is still exporting many unprocessed natural resources and simple manufactures not complex products with a low income elasticity of demand.
