Read the following model of a historical narrative about the presidential debate in 1960, between John F. Kennedy and Richard M. Nixon. Notice that it includes the characteristics you have learned.

The First Televised Presidential Debate

The central character describes his surroundings.

Normally my job is pretty routine, but I saw something tonight that I'll remember for a long time. I'm a cameraman, and tonight I worked at WBBM Studios in Chicago, where the first presidential debate took place between Vice President Nixon and Senator Kennedy.

This first debate has turned into a big deal. The whole setup for the debate was really brand new, since the television networks all gave an hour of free time—no commercials. President Eisenhower even signed a special law to allow it. So it was definitely a very big deal.

The writer included historical events in the narrative.

When I got to the station late this afternoon, everyone seemed pretty keyed up. I was too—I was really worried about not making any mistakes. I was really excited when the two candidates arrived. Vice President Nixon got there first, with a Secret Service man. Nixon wore a baggy-looking gray suit that made him blend into the back wall. Not good. His shirt collar looked too big, and I remember that he'd had some kind of bad leg injury a few weeks before, so maybe he lost weight in the hospital. Also not good.

The writer blends fiction and nonfiction to create the narrative.

Then Senator Kennedy came. Kennedy seemed younger than Nixon and was definitely healthier looking — all tanned. His suit was dark blue, which contrasted well with the gray wall. Kennedy wore a white shirt, which looked great with his dark suit and tan. But white is terrible on television, since it starts to glow. Someone had to get him a light-blue shirt. The director offered the candidates makeup. The Vice President said "No" (bad idea, since he was pretty pale). But the senator, who was already tanned, thought he wanted some (smart—it keeps your face from showing sweat).

students and upper level undergraduate students of history and philosophy In addition the book may also attract intellectuals generally considered who are interested in how philosophy can inform and question historical practice The Arabian Oral Historical Narrative Saad Abdullah Sowayan,1992 *Time, Temporality, and History in Process* Organization Studies Juliane Reinecke,Roy Suddaby,Ann Langley,Haridimos Tsoukas,2020-12-24 Time timing and temporality are inherently important to organizational process studies yet time remains an under theorized construct that has struggled to move much beyond chronological conceptions of clock time Missing from this linear view are ongoing debates about objectivity versus subjectivity in the experience of time linear versus alternative structures of time or an appreciation of collective or culturally determined inferences of temporality This is critical as our understanding of time and temporality can shape how we view and relate to organizational phenomena either as unfolding processes or stable objects History is equally important While we have an intuitive sense of history as a process organizational theorists have struggled to move beyond two limited conceptualizations history as a constraint on organization s capacity for change or history as a unique source of competitive advantage Both approaches suffer from the restrictive view of history as an objective set of brute facts that are exterior to the individuals organizations and collectives that experience them Yet management theory is acquiring an awareness of time history and memory as critical elements in processes of organizing This volume draws together emerging strands of interest in adopting a more nuanced orientation toward time temporality and history to better understand the temporal aspects of organizational processes *Education and Historical Justice* James Miles,Matthew R.
